The City has not raised the sanitation fee since 2018 and with increases in costs for materials, equipment and labor, a rate plan will be presented for the next 5 years. The rate plan will factor in the expected growth of the city population as

well as the need for vehicles, capital improvements, and the addition of personnel. City staff will also present several changes to existing ordinances

associated with collection of solid waste.
