Acceptable Materials for Recycling

Container Products



Aluminum

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted:

Aluminum beverage and food cans.

Not Accepted: Pie plates, aluminum foil, and food contaminated cans.

Preparation: Rinse cans. Do not flatten.



Glass

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted: Clear, brown, and green glass bottles and food jars.

Not Accepted: Window glass, light bulbs, crystal, ceramic or cookware. No drinking

alasses.

Preparation: Rinse bottles and discard lids.



Plastics

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted: Bottles with necks.

Not Accepted: Oil bottles, no containers with metal hangers or containers contaminated

with food.

Preparation: Remove lids and rinse. Do not flatten.



Preparation:

Steel / Tin Cans

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted:
All tin / steel food cans.

Not Accepted: Food contaminated cans, aerosol

cans and paint cans. Rinse can and lids.

Paper Products



Corrugated Cardboard

All Sites/Beside Curbside Bins/Transfer Station

Accepted:
Cardboard boxes

Not Accepted: Waxed lined or laminated coated boxes,

no food soiled or oil contaminated boxes.

Preparation: Remove wood, peanuts and other Styrofoam packing materials. Flatten boxes.



Paperboard

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted: Paperboard cartons/boxes (cereal, cake mix, Kleenex, etc. boxes)

Not Accepted: Waxed lined or laminated coated boxes,

no food soiled boxes.

Preparation: Flatten boxes.



Newspaper/Magazines

All Sites/Curbside Bins

Accepted: Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, junk mail and phone books.

Not Accepted: Wet paper. No magazines wrapped in plastic.

Yard Waste



City & Towns: Check with city or town for curb side pick up date for your area.

County: The County Container sites and the Transfer Station accept yard waste during their hours of operation.

Automotive Products



Anti-Freeze

Only Accepted at Transfer Station

Accepted: Used anti-freeze from cars & other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Anti-freeze contaminated with other ma-

terials.

Preparation: Store in sturdy, closed container.



Lead Acid Batteries

All County Container Sites/Transfer Station

Accepted:

Batteries from cars, trucks, boats, etc.

Not Accepted: Household batteries (dry cell and nickel-

cadmium).

Preparation: Store intact. If possible, exchange when

purchasing new battery.



Motor Oil

All County Container Sites/Transfer Station

Accepted:

Used motor oil from cars and other vehicles.

Oil Filters

Only Accepted at Bells Fork and Ayden-Grifton County Container Sites and Transfer Station

Accepted:

Used oil filters from cars and other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Used motor oil contaminated with antifreeze and other materials.

Preparation: Store in sturdy, closed containers.



Tires

Transfer Station Only

Accepted: Truck and car tires.

Preparation: Tires must be taken off the rim.

Other Products



White Goods/Appliances

City & Towns: Check with city or town for curb side pick up date for your area.

bunty: The County Container sites and Transfer Station accept white goods during their hours of operation.



Electronics

Only Accepted at Transfer Station

Accepted:

Computers, CPUs, monitors, copiers, fax machine scanners, etc.



Oyster Shells

Only Accepted at Bells Fork and Port Terminal County Container Sites and Transfer Station

Accepted:

Oyster shells free of trash and contaminates.



Eyeglasses Only at County Container Sites

Accepted:

Prescription eyeglasses.

Not Accepted: Non-prescription eyeglasses, no cases.

Items Not Accepted

- Sharps/Needles: If you dispose of these items by placing them in a heavy plastic jug or bottle and tightly securing the lid DO NOT place that plastic jug or bottle in recycling bins.
