

Open Burning

The City of Greenville Ordinance 12-1-19 states that no person shall cause, suffer, allow or permit open burning of refuse or other combustible materials, including, for illustrative purposes only and not as a complete or exhaustive list, leaves, tree branches, yard trimmings, construction materials or scrap materials.

A permit may be issued by the Fire Marshal for bonfires and open burning with the coordination and consent of the US Forestry Service. Permit approval will be granted on the sole discretion of the Fire Marshal (NC Fire Code Section 105 and NFPA 1). The following will be needed before the issuance of the permit:

□ \$50 Application Fee

■ **Notification** – An appointment will need to be set with the Fire Marshal to discuss the conditions of the burning. Upon Fire Marshal approval, a signed permit will be given to the requestor.
