Demolition of the Old Outdoor Pool

The City of Greenville Recreation and Parks Department plans to dedicate the Greenville Outdoor Aquatic Center on June 3, 2022. Opening the new pool this summer allows staff to proceed with demolition of the old outdoor pool located at Guy Smith Park which is approximately 50 years old.

After a competitive bid process, Corbett Clearing & Demolition, LLC was selected to perform the work for a price of \$47,750. The site will be cleared, graded, and seeded. The existing parking lot will remain to allow for parking at sporting events. In addition, a portion of the metal roofing material on the old bathhouse will be used to improve the roof of the Prep Field scores tower.

The demolition, which is to be completed by the end of June, will not impact any programming or other services taking place in the park.
