GASSL CODE OF CONDUCT

GASSL's Participant Code of Conduct ensures we create a supportive environment for our swimmers and coaches so every athlete can achieve their full potential.

- 1. GASSL participants, through their actions and conduct, will exhibit good sportsmanship and encourage others to do the same at all times. GASSL parents will serve as positive role models for their children and teammates.
- 2. GASSL families will respect and cooperate with coaches, team members, opponents, spectators, and officials at all times.
- 3. GASSL participants respect the integrity of swim officials by assuming decisions are based on honest, objective evaluations of performance. Only coaches may approach meet officials.
- 4. GASSL parents recognize GASSL coaches are professionals and allow them to coach without interference. GASSL parents leave coaching to the coaches and respect all coaching decisions such as practice group assignments, meet entries, training focus, etc.
- 5. GASSL participants with a concern related to any coach or official within GASSL, should discuss the concern with the team's coach or representative privately and in a professional manner. If the response is unsatisfactory, a GASSL parent may submit a formal written, signed and dated statement to the GASSL Board Chair. The Board chair is authorized to create a panel of 3 Board members who, in their discretion, will review the matter and make a decision that is final and cannot be appealed.
- GASSL participants should know the use of audio or visual recording, including a cell phone camera, is not allowed in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms at any time.
- 7. GASSL participants will comply with all facility guidelines at events GASSL attends.
- 8. GASSL discriminatory conduct will not be tolerated in any form. All concerns will be addressed by a swim jury that will be determined before the start of each season.

Any violation of this code will be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors, which will issue the appropriate response. This response could include one or more of the following: verbal or written reprimand, probation, or temporary/permanent suspension.
