2020-2029 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

- The STIP is a 10-year plan
- Normally updated every 2 years, this year we will update on a 3 year cycle
- 2020-2029 Draft STIP was released August 7, 2019
- Board of Transportation approved it last week




Changes in the 2020-2029 STIP

- Due to a combination of events, many project schedules were moved out
- The 2018-2027 STIP reflected an ambitious plan to expedite program delivery and reduce our cash balance by adding and accelerating many projects
- 65% of the adjustments were due to Project Scoping issues.
 - Project Scopes grew
 - Right of Way estimates were low
 - Inflation cost of construction
- 35% of the adjustments were related to cash flow balancing efforts
 - Map Act Settlements
 - Currently has cost \$311 million
 - Disasters/Storm Recovery
 - Between 2004 and 2016 averaged \$66 million/year
 - Since 2017 we have averaged \$220 million/year

R-2250 – NC 11/NC 903 Greenville Southwest Bypass

- NC 11 to US 264
 (Greenville Bypass).
 Construct four lane
 divided facility on new
 location with bypasses of
 Winterville and Ayden
- Awarded to Barnhill Contracting Company
- Anticipate having mainline open Fall 2019
- Final completion Summer 2020



I-6035 - US 264 (Future I-587)

- Project added as a revision to the 2018-2027 STIP in June 28, 2018
- Upgrade and resurface 13.2 miles of existing roadway from Greene County Line to Stantonsburg Road (SR 1467) Interchange at Greenville Southwest Bypass
- Project Cost: \$22.5 million
- GARVEE Bond Funded
- Awarded to ST Wooten Corporation May 21, 2019
- Contract Completion Date of September 2021




Deliverable Projects

- Projects that have funding in the first 5 years of the STIP
- Currently being developed
- Are not required to be scored again in the STIP process (locked in)

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
Tar River Bridge B-4786

- \$10,000,000 total cost including ROW
- Bridge replacement on NB Bridge on US 13 Memorial Blvd
- ROW in progress CON FY 2021
- Onsite detour during construction




U-5730 – US 13 (Memorial Drive)

- Upgrade intersection with NC 43 (5th Street)
- Project was originally funded in the 2015-2025 STIP
- Delayed from FY 2019 to FY 2020 to allow for additional time for right of way acquisition
- Project Cost: \$2,200,000



U-5606 – SR 1598 (Dickinson Avenue)

- Improve Roadway from NC 11 to Reade Circle
- Construction delayed from FY 2020 to FY 2022 to assist in balancing funds
- Project Cost \$12,054,000



U-5952 – Greenville Signal System


- Upgrade the Greenville Signal System
- Originally included in the 2018-2027 STIP
- Construction delayed from FY 2020 to FY 2023 to assist in balancing funds
- Project Cost \$ 10,182,000





U-5917 – SR 1704 (14th Street)

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from Red Banks Road to SR 1708 (Firetower Road)
- Originally included in the 2018-2027 STIP
- Right of way is scheduled for FY 2020, includes BUILD NC Bonds
- Construction delayed from FY 2021 to FY 2024 to assist in balancing funds
- Project Cost \$ 18,078,000
- Project to be combined and Let with U-5785 and U-5870 (Firetower Rd projects)



U-5785 – SR 1708 (Firetower Road)

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from West of Arlington Boulevard) to SR 1704 (14th Street)
- Originally included in the 2015-2025 STIP
 - Right of way scheduled for FY 2025 and Construction was unfunded
- The project was accelerated in the 2018-2027 STIP
 - Right of way was scheduled for FY 2020 and Construction was scheduled in 2020
- Construction delayed from FY 2020 to FY 2024 to assist in balancing funds in the 2020-2029 STIP
- Project Cost \$ 31,060,000
- Project to be combined and let with U-5917 and U-5870.

U-5870 – SR 1708 (Firetower Road)

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from SR 1704 (14th Street) to NC 33
- Originally included in the 2015-2025 STIP
 - Right of way scheduled for FY 2020 and Construction was scheduled for 2022
- The project was accelerated in the 2018-2027 STIP
 - Construction was scheduled in 2020
- Construction delayed from FY 2020 to FY 2024 to assist in balancing funds in the 2020-2029 STIP
- Project Cost \$ 36,256,000
- Project to be combined and let with U-5917 and U-5870.

U-5875 – SR 1203 (Allen Road)

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from SR1467 (Stantonsburg Road) to US 13 (Dickinson Avenue Extension)
- Originally included in the 2018-2027 STIP
- Right of way acquisition is currently underway
- Construction delayed from FY 2021 to FY 2024 to

assist in balancing funds

Project Cost \$30,463,000




U-2817 – Evans Street/Old Tar Road

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from SR 1711 (Worthington Road to Red Banks Rd
- Originally included in the 2015-2025
 STIP
 - Right of way scheduled for FY 2023 and Construction in FY 2025
- The project was accelerated in the 2018-2027 STIP
 - Right of way is scheduled for FY 2020 and Construction in 2021
- Construction delayed from FY 2021 to FY 2024 to assist in balancing funds in the 2020-2029 STIP
- Project Cost \$ 124,016,000




U-5991 - NC 43 South

- Widen existing road to multilanes from SR 1708 (Firetower Road) to SR 1711 (Worthington Road)
- Originally included in the 2018-2027 STIP
- Right of way scheduled for FY 2021
- Construction delayed from FY 2023 to FY 2024 to assist in balancing funds
- Build NC Bond Funding for construction
- Project Cost \$36,840,000



Projects in Developmental Program

- Projects that have funding in the last 4 years of the STIP
- Are required to be scored again in the STIP process



U-6197 – Worthington Road


- Upgrade intersection at SR 1725 (County Home Road)
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2025
- Construction scheduled in FY 2027
- Project Cost \$ 2,310,000






U-6125 – 10th Street

- Access Management from Oxford Road to Evans Street
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP in the Developmental Program for planning and design
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2029
- Project Cost \$ 25,710,000






U-6196 – Evans Street


- Access Management from SR 1155 (Red Banks Road) to West 5th Street
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP in the Developmental Program for planning and design
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2028

- Widen existing road to multi-lanes from SR 1755 (Blackjack-Simpson Road) to SR 1760 (Mobley's Bridge Road)
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP in the Developmental Program for planning and design
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2029
- Project Cost \$86,969,000





U-6195 – Stantonsburg Road


- Access Management from SR 1204 (B's Barbeque Road) to NC 11 (Memorial Drive)
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP in the Developmental Program for planning and design
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2027
- Construction delayed from FY 2029 to Future Years to assist in balancing funds

Project <u>Cost \$ 30,410,000</u>



U-6147 – Charles Boulevard

- Access Management from US 264 Alt. (Greenville Boulevard) to SR 1708 (Firetower Rd)
- New project added to the 2020-2029 STIP in the Developmental Program for planning and design
- Scheduled for right of way in FY 2029
- Construction unfunded in future years
- Project Cost \$ 18,710,000





