- A. Eric Gooby (Pitt County)
 - 1. No report.
- B. Taylor Cabaniss (Vidant Medical Center)
 - 1. Will present to the Pitt County Board of Health on 03.14.2017 at 6:00pm regarding statistics, education, Watch4Me, Vision Zero, and future construction.
- C. Sgt. Mike Ross (Greenville Police Department)
 - 1. No report.
- D. Jeff Cabaniss (NCDOT)
 - 1. Shared handout on how road projects are scored.
 - 2. Adding a bike lane to a road is only adding one foot of space.
 - 3. Sidewalks are used for two purposes; for pedestrians and they also cover water/sewer lines. Greenville is a 60/40 split in regards to paying for sidewalks. City Council has to approve the cost share.
 - 4. Fire Tower/Portertown expansion looking at Public Input meetings in May. Construction to begin in 06.2019.
 - 5. Allen Road Public Input meeting on 03.27 at Lake Forest Elementary School.
 - 6. 14th St/Fire Tower to Greenville Boulevard will have 16' foot median. Right of Way anticipated to be complete in 2019 with construction beginning in 2021. Discussion ensued.
 - Evans Street Expansion Engineers are on hold with the project because NCDOT cannot do what City Council wants them to do. Currently waiting on the City to respond. There is no withdrawal date by NCDOT as of yet.

VIII. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

- A. Public Works (Lynn Raynor)
 - Green Mill Run Greenway The greenway has been completed. Ribbon Cutting is scheduled for 03.18 at 9:30am, with parking at Blounts Recreational Sports Complex. Community Tree Day event will follow with ReLeaf to plant 120-140 trees along the greenway. Other projects are ongoing for greenway beautification.
 - South Tar Greenway Phase III Currently addressing CSX comments and will return next week. CSX has 60 days to address City's comments. Hope to move forward in June/July.
 - 3. Arlington/Red Banks/Fire Tower milling and striping project. Thinks there may be a striped bike lane, however will need to follow up on that information. Commissioner Harris recommended sharrows.
