# **Entry Fee and Registration Forms**

- \$450 team entry fee will be required, due by Thursday, September 5
- In addition to the team fee, a participation fee of **\$20** (Greenville City Resident); **\$30** (Non-Resident) is required for each member on the team roster which includes players, coaches, and managers.
- These fees should be paid online or in person at H. Boyd Lee Park (Mon-Fri; 12PM-8PM).

### **Uniforms**

- All uniforms must be completed by the first regular season game.
- Uniforms consist of every player on each team wearing a shirt of the same color with a screen-printed or ironed on number on the back of their shirt that is not a duplicate of another team member.

### **Important Dates**

- The deadline to turn in team fees is **Thursday, September 5**
- MANDATORY MANAGERS MEETING will be on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 11</u>, <u>2024</u>, <u>at 6:00 PM</u> at Boyd Lee Park. Failure to attend this meeting (manager or team representative) will result in removal from the league with a full refund. Regular season schedules will be given out at the meeting.
