Welcome to the Greenville Community Pool

Please help us to keep everyone safe and have fun.

- All children 14 & under must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 16 (ID required). All children age 5 & under must be within arm's reach of an adult when in the pool. Children may not be left unattended.
- 2. Swimmers 16 & under will be required to take a swim test to use the 4 foot+ section of the pool. Please ask a lifeguard or attendant for further directions to take a swim test.
- 3. Swimming aids for small children may be borrowed at bunk house.
- 4. No glass, pets, alcohol, illegal substances, smoking, hard candy or gum allowed.
- 5. Food and drink are not allowed on the pool deck and may only be consumed in the picnic area. Please clean up after yourself.
- 6. Please do not go to the bathroom in the pool. Swimmers with open sores, casts, wounds or cuts may be prohibited from pool use. Swimmers that have recently had diarrhea should not use the pool.
- 7. Children not yet potty-trained must wear a swim diaper or leak proof swim pant. Diapers available for purchase at bunk house.
- 8. Appropriate bathing attire required. Bathing attire should cover swimmer and should not impede swimming ability.
- 9. Toys are allowed at the discretion of aquatic staff, no balls at this time please. Flotation devices not approved by the U.S. Coast Guard are considered toys.
- 10. Walk, don't run around the pool.
- 11. Rough play, bullying and profanity are not allowed.
- 12.Jumping in is allowed in the lap pool; diving, jumping backwards or holding hands while jumping are not allowed. Do not jump on anybody.
- 13. The pool may close for inclement weather or bio accidents. No refunds will be given in such cases.
- 14.Not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 15.Listen to instructions from the aquatic staff.
- 16. Failure to follow pool rules may result in ejection.
