



The Greenville Police Department's Use of Force policy (4.3.2) states "the Greenville Police Department does not authorize the use of neck restraints or similar weaponless control techniques as a routine response to resistance aggression (RRA). Annual in-service RRA training will include the progression of force to include verbal, physical, non-lethal, and lethal."

Chokeholds and strangleholds are not a part of the State of North Carolina Subject Control and Arrest Techniques (SCAT) training.
