Title of Item:	Presentation on City Council conducting a quasi-judicial hearing (Special use permit for a master plan community)
Explanation:	The Council will consider a special use permit for a master plan community at its February 11, 2021 meeting. The City's Zoning Ordinance provides that City Council is the public body that issues special use permits for a specific master plan community. See Code Section 9-4-166. In preparation for the upcoming quasi-judicial public hearing, the City Attorney's Office will make a brief presentation about quasi-judicial procedures. Quasi-judicial procedures must be followed when a public body hears a request for a special use permit.
