The Greenville Police Department in collaboration with Pitt County Schools has partnered to offer the Police Athletic League (PAL) Summer Camp Programs of 2021 at Eastern Elementary School, E.B. Aycock and Lake Forest Elementary School. PAL Summer Camp Programs are designed to allow children grades K-7th the opportunity to participate in summer recreational activities, field trips in the local surrounding and STEM learning; PAL staff will strive to maintain a counselor to student ratio of 1:5.

Parents/Guardians will be responsible for transporting their child to and from the PAL sites each day. Your child should <u>ARRIVE</u> between 7:30am & 8:15am. All children should <u>DEPART no later than 5:30pm</u> for each site. The PAL Program schedule of activities includes, arts and crafts, music and rhythms, bowling, field trips, movies, picnicking active and passive games. The summer camps will be staffed with Greenville Police Officers, Site Supervisor, PAL assistants, and volunteers who will be trained to work with children from a diverse background.

To be fair, children are accepted into the PAL Summer Program based upon online application availability submittal,

Police Athletic League (PAL) Program Program Rules

- \checkmark All participants shall display appropriate behavior, showing respect to themselves and to others.
- \checkmark No child will be able to leave with anyone not authorized on application and who is not 18 years or older.
- \checkmark You must be on time to pick your child up.
- ✓ If late picking up your child there is a fee of \$5 per child for every 5 mins that must be paid before your child returns to the PAL program.
- ✓ 3 late pickups in one semester, for any reason, will result in your child not being able to attend the rest of the afterschool program.
- ✓ Fees are due before the child is enrolled. If the fee is not paid by this time, then your child will be taken off of the roster and be placed on the waiting list.
- ✓ No child/parent will have alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs in their possession while at PAL.
- ✓ No child will have any electronic devices in their possession, if found they will be taken away and held till the end of the semester.
- ✓ All participants will follow and comply with all instructions given to them by PAL staff.
- ✓ If a child is accepted to the program, they are expected to come every day.
- ✓ If a child is going to miss a day you are expected to call and let us know 24hrs prior.
- ✓ If your child misses 5 days of after school in one semester they will be removed from the program and replaced by a child on the waiting list.
- ✓ You must sign your child in and out every day unless otherwise advised.
