PAL SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

The Greenville Police Department in collaboration with Greenville Recreation and Parks has partnered to offer the Police Athletic League (PAL) Summer Camp Programs. The Summer Camp Programs are designed to allow children grades K-8th the opportunity to participate in recreational activities through a fun learning summer experience.

Parents/Guardians will be responsible for transporting their child to and from our PAL Center Sites each day. Your child should arrive between 7:30am and 8:15am. All children should be picked up by 5:30pm. The PAL Program schedule of activities include, arts and crafts, field trips, STEM, and indoor/outdoor active games. The Summer Camps will be staffed with Greenville Police Officers, Site Supervisor and PAL Assistants.

Police Athletic League (PAL) Program Rules

- ✓All participants shall display appropriate behavior, showing respect to themselves and to others.
- ✓No child will be able to leave with anyone not authorized on application and who is not 18 years or older.
- ✓You must be on time to pick your child up. Unless prior noticed provided to supervisor of the site
- ✓If you are late picking up your child there is a fee of \$5 per child for every 5 mins that must be paid before your child returns to the PAL program.
- ✓Fees are due before the child is enrolled. If the fee is not paid by this time, then your child will be taken off the roster and be placed on the waiting list.
- ✓No child/parent will have alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs in their possession while at PAL.
- ✓All participants will follow and comply with all instructions given to them by PAL staff.
- ✓If a child is accepted to the program, they are expected to come every day unless prior notice is given to PAL staff.
- ✓If a child is going to miss a day you are expected to call and let us know 24hrs prior.
- ✓If a child misses 5 unexcused days of after-school in one semester they are subject to be removed from the program and replaced by a child on the waiting list.
- ✓You must sign your child in and out every day unless otherwise advised.
