WHEREAS, organ and tissue donors truly bestow the "gift of life" as one donor can save or enhance the lives of as many as 50 people; and

WHEREAS, faith communities participate in services and programs to bring greater awareness and education about the critical need for organ and tissue donations in order to increase the number of names on the donor registry;

*NOW, THEREFORE,* I, Patricia C. Dunn, Mayor of the City of Greenville, North Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 11-13, 2011 as
