## **NEW BUSINESS**

5. **Green Ways and Neighborhood Trails:** Lisa Kirby, Director of Engineering, Eliud De Jesus, Transportation Specialist
  - Eliud gave a PowerPoint presentation on Greenville's Active Transportation Master Plan which includes green ways, bike ways, sidewalks, and shared use paths.
  - Projects are prioritized through a Ranked and Weighted Criteria Chart and submitted to NC Dept. of Transportation for funding.
  - An online interactive mapping tool is available to view current bicycle and pedestrian facilities and proposed recommendationsNAB members inquired about several road, side walk, and green way projects, and city staff provided the following information.
  1. NCDOT projects the installation of sidewalks on Evans Street between (14th St. and Red Banks Rd.) for 2029
  2. Widening of Evans St. from Greenville Blvd to Winterville including side walks and bike lanes is scheduled for 2025
  3. A sidewalk project for the 10th Street Corridor from Evans St. to Pinewood Cemetery (Portertown Rd.) is scheduled for 2029
  4. The next NCDOT project in Greenville is Dickinson Avenue Improvement
  5. The Allen Road widening from Statonsburg Road to Dickinson Avenue Extension is scheduled for 2024
  6. If a neighborhood has a suggestion for a path in their location, it can be aired at the public comment period at the next update of the plan or reach out to MPO and the Multimodal Transportation Commission
  7. The city does not designate a difference between neighborhood trails and green ways
  8. The current greenway project is the South Tar River Greenway-Phase 3
