### **Policy Statement**

It is the policy of the City of Greenville and Greenville Utilities Commission to provide minorities and women equal opportunity for participating in all aspects of the City's and Utilities' contracting and procurement programs, including but not limited to, construction projects, supplies and materials purchases, and professional and personal service contracts.

### **Goals and Good Faith Efforts**

Bidders responding to this solicitation shall comply with the MWBE program by making Good Faith Efforts to achieve the following aspiration goals for participation.

Bidders shall submit MWBE information with their bids on the forms provided. This information will be subject to verification by the City prior to contract award. As of July 1, 2009, contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, service providers, or MWBE members of joint ventures intended to satisfy City MWBE goals shall be certified by the NC Office of Historically Underutilized Businesses (NC HUB) only. Firms qualifying as "WBE" for City's goals must be designated as a "women-owned business" by the HUB Office. Firms qualifying as "MBE" for the City's goals must be certified in one of the other categories (i.e.: Black, Hispanic, Asian American, American Indian, Disabled, or Socially and Economically Disadvantaged). Those firms who are certified as both a "WBE" and "MBE" may only satisfy the "MBE" requirement. Each goal must be met separately. Exceeding one goal does not satisfy requirements for the other. However, for participation purposes, all MWBE vendors who wish to do business as a minority or female must be certified by NC HUB.

The Bidder shall make good faith efforts to encourage participation of MWBEs prior to submission of bids in order to be considered as a responsive bidder. Bidders are cautioned that even though their submittal indicates they will meet the MWBE goal, they should document their good faith efforts and be prepared to submit this information, if requested.

The MWBE's listed by the Contractor on the **Identification of Minority/Women Business Participation** which are determined by the City to be certified shall perform the work and supply the materials for which they are listed unless the Contractors receive <u>prior authorization</u> from the City to perform the work with other forces or to obtain materials from other sources. If a contractor is proposing to perform all elements of the work with his own forces, he must be prepared to document evidence satisfactory to the owner of similar government contracts where he has self-performed.

### **Minimum Compliance Requirements:**

All written statements, affidavits, or intentions made by the Bidder shall become a part of the agreement between the Contractor and the City for performance of contracts. Failure to comply with any of these statements, affidavits or intentions or with the minority business guidelines shall constitute a breach of the contract. A finding by the City that any information submitted (either prior to award of the contract or during the performance of the contract) is inaccurate, false, or incomplete, shall also constitute a breach of the contract. Any such breach may result in termination of the contract in accordance with the termination provisions contained in the contract. It shall be solely at the option of the City whether to terminate the contract for breach or not. In determining whether a contractor has made Good Faith Efforts, the CITY will evaluate all efforts made by the Contractor and will determine compliance in regard to quantity, intensity, and results of these efforts.

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Wednesday, June 29, 2022 at 2:00 PM for the subject project. A Pre-Bid Conference sign-in sheet is attached with a list of the attendees.

Following introductions of meeting attendees and a general project overview, the following specific items were discussed:

- 1. Bidders were reminded that the Bid Date is July 13, 2022 at 2:00 PM at the City of Greenville, Engineering Dept., 1500 Beatty Street, Greenville, NC 27834. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the City of Greenville, 1500 Beatty Street, Greenville, NC 27834 and the outside of the envelope must be marked "Bid for City of Greenville Atlantic Avenue Parking Lot B".
- 2. It is the Contractor's responsibility to visit the project site and become familiar with the work prior to bidding.
- 3. Although the Engineer and Owner will make a sincere effort to answer all questions to the best of their ability, Bidders are reminded to rely only on written information contained in the Contract Documents and Addenda.
- 4. Should the bidder find discrepancies in, or omission from, the drawings or documents or should he be in doubt as to their meaning, he shall notify the Engineer in writing. Any product substitution requests shall also be submitted to the Engineer in writing. All questions shall be submitted in writing, email is acceptable, by 5:00 pm on Thursday, July 7, 2018
- 5. A Bid Bond in the amount of 5% and 100% Payment and Performance Bonds will be required.
- 6. Construction Time Limit & Liquidated Damages:

- 7. This project will be bid as a single contract for all work.
- 8. The Bid Form must be completed in its entirety.
- 9. Bidders shall comply with the City of Greenville Minority and Women Business Enterprise program by making Good Faith Efforts to achieve the following aspiration goals for participation: 10% for Minority Business Enterprises and 6% for Women Business Enterprises. Bidders shall submit MWBE information with their bids on the forms provided in the contract documents. This information will be subject to verification by the City prior to contract award. Contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, service providers, or MWBE members of joint ventures intended to satisfy City MWBE goals shall be certified by the NC Office of Historically Underutilized Businesses (NC HUB) only. - 10. General contractors are notified that Chapter 87, Article 1, 2 & 4 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, will be observed in receiving and awarding general contracts. General contractors submitting bids on this project must have license classification for Highway or Unclassified.
- 11. The City's intention is to execute a construction contract upon evaluating bids received and approval of the construction contract by the Greenville City Council. Notice to Proceed will be given promptly upon approval so work may begin in September or early October.
- 12. Local Preference Policy: The City of Greenville has adopted a Local Preference Policy, Resolution No. 056-13, and a Professional and other Services Policy, Resolution No. 057-13 that will pertain to this project. For more information, please see the City of Greenville's webpage at www.greenvillenc.gov/financialservices/purchasingdivision.
- 13. Iran Divestment Act Legislation: By agreeing to the terms and conditions of the contract, the Vendors certify that:
  (i) it is not on the Iran Final Divestment List created by the NC State treasurer pursuant to N.C.G.S. 147-86.58; (ii) it will not take any actions causing it to appear on said list during the term of any contract with the City, and (iii) it will not utilize any subcontractor to provide goods and services hereunder that is identified on said list.
- 14. E-Verify Compliance: The Bidder shall comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. Further, if the Bidder furnishes services, programs or goods to the City utilizing a subcontractor, the Bidder shall require the subcontractor to comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The Bidder represents that the Bidder and its subcontractors are in compliance with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes.
- 15. The following items were discussed during the meeting:
  - A project limits fence is not required, however, It is the Contractor's responsibility to maintain a safe, secure job site. A fence is allowable if the Contractor chooses to install one.
  - A site office trailer is not required.
  - The Contractor is responsible for coordinating the relocation of existing electric and communication utilities with the utility providers.



- Before starting construction, Contractor shall submit a detailed project schedule including the times
  for starting and completing the various stage of the Work. This schedule shall also include critical
  tasks such as the relocation of utilities and estimated material delivery schedules. Extensions to the
  contract duration due to delays caused by Utility providers or material delays will only be granted
  based on adequate documentation of impacts to the critical path as shown on the approved schedule.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for staking the light poles for installation by Greenville Utilities.
- The Contractor is responsible for construction staking by a Professional Land Surveyor.
- The Contractor will be required to provide a red line set of record drawings at the completion of this
  project.
- The installation of the storm pipe within the Eighth Street Right of Way is included as Alternate bid work.
- The award of the contract will be based on the base bid only. The Alternate will be awarded if adequate project funds are available.
- 16. An Addendum to the Bid Documents will be issued. Bidders are reminded to indicate their receipt of all Addenda in the space provided on the Bid Form and attach the Addenda to the Bid Submittal.

Any errors, omissions or ambiguities shall be submitted in writing to the attention of the undersigned within 7 days.
