Subject:	TRANSIT OPEN HOUSE	

Public Works will be conducting a public meeting on Thursday, December 8, 2022. The meeting will take place at the G.K. Butterfield Transportation Center between 10:30 am and 2:30 pm. Representatives from Public Works/GREAT and our consultant partner, AECOM, will host an open house to share information and gather feedback on proposed improvements to transit service in Greenville.

A welcome table will be set up within the lobby at G.K. Butterfield Transportation Center to share project updates and collect comments and suggestions from the public on the ongoing Improved Mobility and Enhancements Plan project. In addition to the meeting within the lobby of the Transportation Center, staff will be engaging with the ridership of Route 4 by riding the bus and describing the plan to convert that route to an on-demand service.

Interactions with current and potential GREAT bus riders will assist the project team with understanding which transit service enhancements are top priorities for community members.

This is the first follow-up meeting with the public after the City Council workshop presentation on this plan to improve Transit services within the City of Greenville. Additional public meetings will be planned based on the feedback from this initial meeting.
