- Cypress Loop 2.1 Miles
- Wildwood Trail 1.6 Miles

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED
NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED

PARK RULES

- All pets must be on a leash and are not allowed in the riding areas
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited.
- No motorized vehicles permitted on trails.
- Please do not cut or remove vegetation or wildlife
- Fish may be taken according to NC Wildlife Resources Commission regulations.
- Fishing license is required
- No fishing or swimming from the kayak launch / boat dock.
- Camping is permitted in designated areas only.
- Park is closed at dusk.

SINGLETRACK RULES

- Helmets are required
- Share the trail with other users
- Check to make sure your bike is in good shape before riding.
- Don't ride on wet trails as it damages them.
- Stay on the trail.
- Travel in the same direction as other riders.
- No motorized vehicles or remote control cars allowed.
- Do not remove or modify any trail features.
- Do not stop in an area other users can not see you.
- Class 1 E-MTBs are allowed, no other electric or electric assist vehicles are allowed
