Proclamation

WHEREAS, bicycle laws and ordinances, bicycle maintenance and repair, injury prevention, and sharing the road with motorists are necessary for bicycle riders of all ages and level of experience; and

WHEREAS, the "Bike to Work" Day on May 16th is an effort to get Greenville residents to commit to riding safely and being more active;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Patricia C. Dunn, Mayor of the City of Greenville, North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 2008 as
