Proclamation

WHEREAS, this year's 2007 Pitt County-Greenville Relay For Life is scheduled from Friday, April 27, 2007 at 6:00 PM to Saturday, April 28, 2007, until 12:00 PM at South Central High School, 570 Forlines Road, Winterville, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Relay for Life is the nationwide signature activity for the American Cancer Society. All functions of the American Cancer Society are represented at the Relay, including fundraising, community cancer awareness, advocacy, and cancer control activities; and

WHEREAS, this is a team event that has families, schools, companies, hospitals, and other community groups create teams of 8 to 15 people who take turns walking around a track overnight to raise money to fight cancer; and

WHEREAS, citizens need not be a runner or even a walker to participate in Relay For Life. The common theme of Relay is to have members of teams continuously walking, running or rolling around a track for 12 or 24 hours, to celebrate the lives of those who have survived cancer, to remember those who have been lost to the disease, and to empower all to fight back against the disease;
