Proclamation

WHEREAS, April 11, 2007 marks the 39th Anniversary of the passage of the U. S. Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, which enunciated a national policy of Fair Housing without regard to race, color, creed, national origin, sex, familial status, and handicap, and encourages fair housing opportunities for all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville-Pitt Association of REALTORS®, are committed to highlight the Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, by continuing to address discrimination in our community, to support programs that will educate the public about the right to equal housing opportunities, and to plan partnership efforts with other organizations to help assure every American of their right to fair housing;

NOW, *THEREFORE*, I, Robert D. Parrott, Mayor of the City of Greenville, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 2007 as

FAIR HOUSING MONTH

AND BE IT RESOLVED that April 2007, being Fair Housing Month, begins a year-long commemoration of the U.S. Fair Housing Law in Greenville and I urge all citizens to wholeheartedly recognize this celebration throughout the year.
