Winter Storm Warning

Persons should consider delaying all travel.

Motorists should use extreme caution if travel is absolutely necessary.

Widespread snow is expected across eastern North Carolina.

Blowing and drifting snow expected, possible blizzard conditions especially Outer Banks.

Biggest impact overnight Tuesday into early Wednesday.

Accumulating snow likely on roads due to temperatures well below freezing.

Anything that melts during the daytime, will re-freeze into black ice at night.

Prolonged period of cold weather may lead to frozen pipes. Breezy conditions may exacerbate this.

Don't forget about your pets.

SHOVEL SMART!



Shoveling heavy, wet snow can cause back injuries and heart attacks. Don't push yourself!



Dress warmly, making sure to cover your head, fingers and toes.



Stay hydrated, but avoid heavy meals right before or after shoveling.



Move only small amounts of snow with each pass of the shovel.



Take frequent breaks.

Stop shoveling entirely if you feel exhausted!



DON'T FORGET YOUR PETS



Even with a natural fur coat, **winter can be deadly** for your pets unless proper care is given.



Keep them warm and dry, and indoors whenever possible.



Provide plenty of food and water. Dehydration is especially dangerous in winter.



When outside, keep them bundled up. Limit outside time, and thoroughly clean (including paws) when bringing them in
