Questions and RFI submitted for discussion by email:

- 1. How many total decedents are currently recorded in the existing system? Answer: Over 11,600.
- 2. Could you please provide the total number of burial records you currently have, broken down by each cemetery?

Answer: All are approximate numbers.

- Are there any future or planned spaces or expansions that will need to be migrated into the new system?
 Answer: Yes. Future planned spaces and/or expansions will be provided once plans are finalized.
- What format is the current data in (e.g. spreadsheets, database exports, proprietary formats)?
 Answer: Proprietary. Data can be provided via exports to the selected firm. Data is also available in paper form.
- 8. Could you provide samples of your existing records? We are particularly interested in understanding the type and number of data fields you currently track (e.g. name of the deceased, date of birth, date of interment, plot location, etc.).

Answer: Yes. Cemetery Data layout, Cemetery Service Request (CSR) form, plot purchase form, interment direction form, and marker permit form are attached. All fields shall be captured with the new software and application.

- The RFP scope mentions data migration from current cemetery software data. Would it be possible to see copies of the data that we would be responsible for migrating?
 Answer: Yes. Refer to question #8.
- Is the City currently using a specific software system for cemetery management? If so, could you please specify?
 Answer: No. The City is using a self-created and developed application.

Answer: No. The City is using a self-created and developed application.

11. Could you confirm the 20 hours of system setup, configuration, training, and project management section is referring to the configuration on the CRM and setup of the system? If so, could you expand on the expectations for this section.

Answer: Yes. The intent is for the selected firm to provide system startup, configuration, training, and project management in two (2), 20-hour blocks of time for a total of forty (40) hours.

12. For the advanced contract reporting section, is this intended to reference the ability to create contracts within the system, along with two (2) associated reports? If not, could you provide more detail on what functionality is being requested?

Answer: This references two (2) users having the ability to create advanced reporting.

- 13. Is the vendor expected to migrate all existing data from the current system to the new platform? Answer: Yes.
- 14. Are there existing digital documents (e.g. PDFs, photos, scanned files) that will need to be imported into the new system?Answer: Yes.
- Are there existing images or digital documents that need to be migrated into the new system? If so, how many images/documents are there?
 Answer: Yes. Over 4,400 documents. These will be provided to the selected firm.
- Are there any existing software systems that the new cemetery solution will have to integrate with? If so, please specify.
 Answer: Yes. ESRI per the RFP.
- Are there any forms (deeds/right of interment) the City is currently using that they would like customized to work in the new system? If so, can the City provide examples of those forms?
 Answer: Yes. Sample deed and interment direction form are attached.
- 18. Is there a requirement to digitize existing physical documents or artifacts (e.g. deeds, ledgers, index cards)? Answer: No. However, this is desirable as budget allows.
- 19. Approximately how many physical documents require digitization (single-sided count)? Answer: None. Over 11,600 records exist. This will be discussed with the selected firm.
- 20. What is the approximate breakdown between handwritten and machine-typed documents? **Answer: This information is unknown.**
- 21. Will the vendor be responsible for on-site digitization, or will the City digitize the documents and provide digital copies to the vendor?Answer: Digitization is not required per the RFP.
- 22. Is there a need or desire to photograph headstones and associate those images with individual records? **Answer: Yes. As budget allows.**
- Is there a requirement or expectation for the vendor to perform a data or document audit for quality assurance before and/or after migration?
 Answer: Yes.
- 24. If possible, could you share samples of your current cemetery maps? We're particularly interested in understanding how the plots are currently laid out and whether any data is included on the maps such as plot ID numbers.
 Answer: Yes. Maps are attached.
- 25. What type of cemetery maps is the City currently using (paper, GIS, CAD)? Can the City provide examples of the existing cemetery maps? Answer: Paper and CAD. Maps are attached.
- 26. For the PDF overlays and interactivity section, is this referring to cemetery map overlays and the interactive features of an online map?Answer: Yes

- 27. Could you confirm the number of columbariums across your cemeteries? Answer: We do not have free standing columbariums. We have niches/crypts in both mausoleums.
- 28. Regarding the 384 niches mentioned in the proposal: Is the number from a single columbarium wall, or is it the total across all cemeteries and the columbarium structures? Answer: 384 are the combined total niches/crypts in both mausoleums at Homestead Memorial Gardens.
- 29. Are there any above ground burials in mausoleums or columbaria in the cemeteries? If so, how many total niches/crypts are there: Answer: Yes. 384 is the total for both mausoleums. Homestead Memorial Gardens Main Mausoleum contains 240 single crypts, 24 double crypts, and 96 niches. Hillside West Mausoleum at Homestead Memorial Gardens contains 24 single crypts.
- 30. Are all four cemeteries currently active and accepting new interments? Answer: Yes.
- 31. Are there any known local or municipal restrictions regarding drone flights over the cemeteries? Answer: No. However, firms will be required to receive permission for takeoff and landing from private property if not flying from City-owned property. FAA airspace authorization is required across most of Greenville, and permissible altitudes will vary. Greenville's airspace is considered "enhanced risk" due to a high volume of aircraft and helicopter traffic, so airspace authorization is not guaranteed. Both Pitt County and the State have unmanned aircraft ordinances/laws that should be followed.

- 34. The current pricing format is quite different from how we typically present our software modules. Would it be acceptable for us to reformat this section to better reflect the way our solution is structured, while still addressing all required components? Answer: No. Proposed solutions shall be provided on the forms in the RFP to maintain fairness for all
- 35. Will there be an addendum issued for this RFP that I should keep an eye out for? Answer: Yes, an addendum will be posted to the City of Greenville website under current bid opportunities by Thursday, May 8 at 5PM. THIS DEED, made this the March 26, 2025 by the City of Greenville, NC, a municipal corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of North Carolina, party of the first part, to:

WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the sum of \$975.00 in hand paid to the party of the first part by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has bargained, sold, granted and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part and his/her heirs and assigns, subject to the conditions and restrictions hereinafter set forth, the exclusive right of burial of the remains of human beings in Lot: <u>31D</u> Space: <u>1</u> Garden: <u>TRINITY</u> or in Mausoleum Section: <u>_</u> Tier: <u>_</u> Crypt: <u>_</u> of Homestead Memorial Gardens Cemetery, as shown by map on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Greenville, North Carolina, together with the right to use the ways and avenues of ingress and egress and the rights, liberties, and privileges of said party of the first part for the purposes herein set forth.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the party of the second part, his/her heirs and assigns, forever, for the use of the burial of human remains only and for no other purpose whatsoever, subject to the following conditions and restrictions, to be exercised in the sole discretion of the party of the first part, to-wit: (1) the right of the party of the first part at all times to enter upon the said lot with its workmen and/or any implements for the purpose of grading and improving said lot, placing, replacing or removing any trees, shrubbery or structures of any kind, (2) the right of the said party of the first part to change in any way the grade or boundaries of the said lot as may be deemed desirable by the party of the first part for the general upkeep and improvement of the said cemetery as a whole, (3) no tombstone, vault, marker, fence, coping, mound or other structure of any kind whatsoever, shall be erected or placed, nor any plants or shrubberies be placed on the said lot except in accordance with the rules and regulations of the said party of the first part or as expressly authorized in writing by the party of the first part, (4) the said party of the second part shall hold the said lot for the uses and purposes herein designated subject to all the rules and regulations which may be deemed desirable by the party of the first part for the conduct and betterment of the said cemetery as a whole, (5) no transfer of this deed or the rights covered hereunder shall be valid unless registered with and approved by said party of the first part and until the transfer fee as required by the party of the first part has been received, and (6) no lot shall be sold for an amount greater than that paid for the same lot by the party of the second part. This conveyance is made subject to an ordinance adopting rules and regulations for the control of city cemeteries and providing penalties in relation thereto. The party of the second part herein, his/her heirs and assigns, agree that upon the breach of any of its provisions, the title to said property shall revert to the City of Greenville, North Carolina.

Typical Plot Block







TYPICAL 16 PLOT BLOCK


