WHEREAS, the Civitan Club of Greenville honors local clergy during Civitan's Clergy Appreciation Week in early February; and

WHEREAS, the Civitan Club of Greenville emphasizes the importance of responsible and worthy citizenship by honoring an outstanding community leader each year as the *citizen of the year* and by sponsoring the Civitan Citizenship award and scholarship in the high schools of Ayden-Grifton, D. H. Conley, Farmville Central, J. H. Rose, North Pitt, and South Central, and

WHEREAS, the Civitan Club of Greenville generously supports Boys and Girls Homes of North Carolina, Lake Waccamaw; and

WHEREAS, the Civitan Club of Greenville contributes time, work, funds, and service to Special Olympics and to other children and adults with mental and physical disabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Civitan Club of Greenville provides resources and funds to the Child Development Unit of the Department of Pediatrics, Duke University Medical Center and the Civitan International Research Center, Birmingham, Alabama, to support research and treatment of mental retardation and other developmental disabilities,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert D. Parrott, Mayor of the City of Greenville, North Carolina, do hereby designate April 2006 as
