WHEREAS, breastfeeding is recognized as an unequaled means of providing food for infants,

*WHEREAS*, research indicates that breastfeeding impacts the growth, development, and wellbeing of the infant by providing nutrition, protection against infections, as well as forming an emotional bond between mother and baby, and

*WHEREAS*, breastfeeding throughout the child's first year of life and beyond, with the appropriate introduction of complementary foods around the middle of the first year, is acknowledged as an important aspect of primary health care, and

*WHEREAS*, government and community organizations have a vested interest in protecting and promoting breastfeeding as a means of preventing infant malnutrition, morbidity and mortality, and

*WHEREAS*, International Board Certified Lactation Consultants and other breastfeeding counselors and educators have an important role in assisting breastfeeding mothers with sustaining lactation, and

*WHEREAS*, World Breastfeeding Week reminds us that support networks that encourage and promote breastfeeding should be fostered in all communities with the theme for 2006, "Code Watch 25 Years of Protecting Breastfeeding",
