WHEREAS, the cleanup will celebrate the 18th Anniversary of the North Carolina Adopt-A-Highway program and its 6,000 volunteer groups that donate their labor and time year round to keep our roadsides clean; and

WHEREAS, the natural beauty of our city and state and a clean environment are sources of great pride for citizens of Greenville and all North Carolinians, attracting tourists and aiding in recruiting new industries; and

WHEREAS, the cleanup will increase awareness of the need for cleaner roadsides, emphasize the importance of not littering, and encourage recycling of solid wastes; and


WHEREAS, the cleanup will be a part of educating the children of Greenville and this great state regarding the importance of a clean environment to the quality of life in North Carolina;
