Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville Annual "Caring Is Sharing" Food Drive will be held from November 4 to November 16 assisting people in need of a helping hand to enable them to feed their families. The collected goods will be distributed on November 16 to five nonprofit Pitt County agencies who provide year-round services to the less fortunate; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville will present a kick-off ceremony and KidsFest on November 4, from 10:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M., at the Town Common. Everyone is encouraged to bring two canned food items or to make a donation. Some of the proposed attractions will be "free" hot dogs and refreshments, face painting, a puppet show, and a variety of children games, along with a Police patrol car and more; and

WHEREAS, the GREAT Transit System will be offering a "Free Ride" Day on November 8. Two or more nonperishable items will be collected instead of the usual fare; and

WHEREAS, the success of the "Caring and Sharing" Food Drive depends upon the participation of businesses, civic groups, educational institutions, churches and individuals in every community; and

WHEREAS, donations will be collected on November 4 - November 15 at designated collection points including the City of Greenville Facilities and all GREAT Buses, Ayden Middle School, C. M. Eppes Middle School, G. R. Whitfield School, Sadie Saulter School, W. H. Robinson School, Belvoir Elementary School, Community Christian Academy, Rivers & Associates, Regional Acceptance (3 locations), Falkland EMS, Minges Coliseum, SET of Eastern Seal - UCP, Mt. Calvary Church Daycare, and Greenville Utilities Commission Facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert D. Parrott, Mayor of the City of Greenville, North Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 4 -16, 2006, as

CARING IS SHARING DAYS

and further proclaim November as

CARING IS SHARING MONTH

and urge all citizens, businesses, and organizations to support the efforts of the City of Greenville and others.
