#### **MEETING AGENDA, DISCUSSION, AND ACTIONS:**

I. ROLL CALL—Quorum was established

Tonight's meeting was a community meeting hosted in City Council District 5.

**Welcome**—Brenda Diggs, President of The Oaks Neighborhood Association, welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming out to support their community.

**NAB introduction**—Lillian Outterbridge, Laura Searfoss, and ECU planning students provided a brief introduction of the Neighborhood Advisory Board.

**Explanation of meeting format**—Ms. Searfoss explained that each table would respond to the following three questions:

- 1. What challenges does your neighborhood face?
- 2. What actions would strengthen your neighborhood?
- 3. How can we get more people involved in your neighborhood?

Participants would then share their responses in their small groups, where a recorder would document all the responses. Upon completion of the meeting, Ms. Searfoss would refer action items to city departments for resolution or further consideration.

**Facilitated Discussion**—Ms. Searfoss is preparing a report that catalogs the common themes among groups and explains how the city departments are responding to citizens' requests from the meeting.

**Code Enforcement Questions and Answers**—Corey Barrett, Code Enforcement Officer, answered questions on behalf of Officer Larry Hopkins, who handles code violations throughout District 5. Mr. Barrett explained the procedures of reporting a violation and reasons why a violation may not be remedied immediately.
