How the City Performed Financially

- ✓ Revenues > Expenses
- ✓ Net \$2.8M Increase in Fund Balance
- ✓ Last Two Fiscal Years Revenue > Expense
- ✓ \$4.46 Cumulative 5-year Net Increase in Fund Balance



Budgeted Revenues - \$77.84 Million

- Year-to-Date \$41.22 Million Actual
- 53% of Annual Budget
- ✤ ↓ \$2.1 Million < December 2011 (5% Reduction)</p>



Budgeted Expenses - \$77.84 Million

- Year-to-Date \$32.27 Million
- 41% of Annual Budget
- FLAT when compared to December 2011
 BALANCE



Revenues over Expenses

- Year-to-Date \$9 Million More Revenues than Expenses
- \$1.9 Million below Prior Year Net Results

Summary of Other Funds at Mid-Year

- Transit is within budget
- Sanitation continues to operate at a deficit (under review)
- Stormwater results vary with timing of capital
