## INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A PETITION FOR A CHANGE IN ZONING CLASSIFICATION

- A petitioner for a zoning change must complete this application in full.
   This application will not be processed unless all information requested is provided.
- 2. The filing fee shall be in accordance with the Manual of Fees.
- 3. An accurate boundary survey of the property proposed for rezoning must accompany the application. The survey must be completed by a registered land surveyor or professional engineer.

The survey shall include:

- (a) vicinity map with a scale no smaller than 1' = 1000';
- (b) north arrow in upper 180 degree quadrant;
- (c) all property lines with dimensions, metes and bounds;
- (d) location of all existing structures and improvements;
- (e) zoning classifications of all surrounding property;
- (f) acreage;
- (g) existing and proposed zoning classifications of subject tract;
- (h) adjoining public and private streets with right-of-ways and paved widths, including future thoroughfare right-of-ways;
- (i) name of adjacent property owners shown within 100 feet;
- (j) name of landowner(s) requesting the zoning change;
- (k) name of person or firm preparing the map;
- (1) standard engineering scale no smaller than 1" = 200'
- (m) date of map.
- 4. The petitioner, or his duly authorized agent, shall submit to the Planning Office the following:
  - (a) one (1) completed application;
  - (b) five (5) paper copies (folded) of the map for staff review; following staff review, one (1) revised paper copy submitted 10 working days prior to the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting;
  - (c) a digital version (PDF) of the final rezoning map;
  - (d) written legal description shall be attached to the application. Also a digital copy (disk, email, cd) of the legal description shall be provided in a Microsoft Word compatible format.
- 5. a. The application must be signed by the landowner(s) or by an authorized agent.
  - b. If signed by an authorized agent, the landowner must sign and have notarized the section of the application that grants the agent authority to act on the owners behalf.
  - 6. Completed requests must be filed with the Community Development Department no later than twenty (20) working days prior to the Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Commission's meeting date in order to be placed on the monthly agenda. The Commission meets regularly on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. and the City Council (CC) public hearing for rezoning petitions is typically the second Thursday of the following month at 7:00 p.m. Meetings are held in the City Council Chambers, third floor of City Hall, located at the corner of West 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Washington Street.
