Purpose

The intention of the poster contest is to increase awareness among students of their right to equal housing opportunity. Federal and state laws prohibit discrimination based on:

- Race
- Color
- Sex
- National Origin
- Religion
- Familial Status
- Disability

Poster Guidelines

Dimensions for the posters are 22 X 28 inches. Suggested materials include, but are not limited to, markers, colored pencils, crayons, paint, and construction paper. Contestants should not be discouraged from participation due to the unavailability of suggested materials.

What is Fair Housing?

In 1968, the United States Congress passed the Fair Housing Act to address housing discrimination based on race, color, religion and national origin.

In 1974 and 1988, the Congress passed legislation which added protection from housing discrimination based on sex, familial status (having children under 18 in the household), and physical or mental disability.

Sponsors information will be listed on the city's webpage, GTV, newspaper articles advertising and programs.

Poster Identification

The following information must be placed on the back of the posters using a ball point pen:

- The entrant's name, grade, school and teacher.
- The name, mailing address, e-mail address, and contact information for parent(s)/guardian(s).

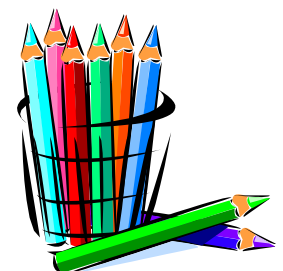
