

WHEREAS, East Carolina University (ECU) established basketball as its first intercollegiate sport in the year 1931;

WHEREAS, the ECU men's basketball team broke many school records with its 2012 – 2013 season, including the first-ever winning record during the regular season of the Conference USA competition, first 20-win season since 1954, best season as a Division 1 school, and highest three-season victory total;

WHEREAS, the Pirates' impressive season resulted in an invitation to compete in the 2013 CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT);

WHEREAS, the Pirates' winning season and CIT invitation sparked a fervor on the campus and within the community, resulting in great enthusiasm and record crowds of support;

WHEREAS, the Pirates succeeded in going all the way to the CIT Championship game – making it the first time in school history that ECU has ever played in a Division 1 post-season championship; and

WHEREAS, the Pirates' thrilling 77 – 74 victory in the last seconds of the CIT Championship game against Utah's Weber State marked ECU's first-ever Division 1 tournament post-season championship.
