



### Instructions to Research Zoning Districts

The City of Greenville Zoning Map's zoning district for specific parcels may be viewed at the City's online mapping system by following the steps below.

1. Go to the website:  
[http://maps.greenvillenc.gov/Freeance/Client/PublicKiosk1/index.html?appconfig=basic\\_map](http://maps.greenvillenc.gov/Freeance/Client/PublicKiosk1/index.html?appconfig=basic_map)
2. When the Disclaimer statement appears, read it and select "Accept."  
Wait for a map to appear in the center of the screen before proceeding with the next step.
3. Near the top left margin, under the heading "Search This Map," select the criteria you want to use to zoom into the parcel. This will usually be the "City Address/Street Lookup" choice. Enter the address, but do not include Street, Drive, Circle, etc. after the name of the roadway, and click "Go." Wait for the map to reappear on the screen which should now be zoomed into the parcel you are researching.
4. To display the zoning district of the property - In the left margin, under the subheading "Customize This Map" select the box next to "Zoning" so that a checkmark appears and click the orange button near the bottom left corner of the screen entitled "Update Map." An abbreviation of the zoning district designation should appear on or over the address you searched.

### Instructions to Look Up Permitted Uses within Specific Zoning Districts

Once you have located the zoning district designation for a particular property and are interested in conducting initial research to ascertain what types of development may be allowed with that zoning district, consult the Table of Uses beginning on page 2. The zoning district abbreviations appear along the top row of the tables. Throughout the table, the letter "P" indicates Permitted Uses while the "S" indicates the uses that require approval of a "Special Use Permit." Blank boxes in the table between a Zoning District and the corresponding row of uses indicates those uses are prohibited.

**DISCLAIMER: The Zoning Ordinance provides numerous additional regulations and procedures regarding zoning districts, however the following Table of Uses may be consulted to conduct initial research of which types of development are allowed in various zoning districts.**

- (2) Special uses are indicated by the letter S.
- (3) (a) Each listed principal use activity is assigned a land use classification number (LUC#) ranging from 1 to 5 for purposes of determining required bufferyards.  
  
(b) In the case of planned centers containing multiple principal uses, such as shopping centers, office/commercial unit ownership type developments and the like, the initial bufferyard requirement shall be based on the anticipated primary occupancy of such center and such requirement shall apply to all subsequent uses absent any change in zoning for such planned center.
- (4) Each listed accessory use activity is assigned an asterisk (\*) in substitution for a land use classification number. Such, and other accessory use(s) shall be subject to the land use classification number of the associated principal use.
